SCARED CARDS

These can be used to support creativity when generating design ideas in Design & Technology and Engineering. They have proved to be particularly effective when used as a challenge to students – 'Are you SCARED of designing'?

- 1. Print out the cards the second page of this document is the card content and the third page is the card backs. If printed double sided these should match up.
- 2. Get students to sketch or model a design idea. This could be generated using, for example, a 4x4 type of layout.
- 3. Deal the cards face down on the desk (SCARED side down). The student picks a random card and has to apply the stated change to their design idea.
- 4. Repeat as many times as required.
